Other specification

- TÜBİTAK shall provide grant(s) for the project costs of Turkish participant(s).
- TÜBİTAK shall consider projects about new product development, development of new techniques and new production technologies to increase the quality or standard of products, or to lower costs as eligible for funding.
- All applications from Turkey should be simultaneously submitted online to TÜBİTAK 1509-International Industrial R&D Projects Funding Programme via the PRODİS application (eteydeb.tubitak.gov.tr) for full-proposals.
- Submitted projects shall be evaluated at the national scale according to the three criteria listed below and a support decision shall be made accordingly.
 - Project's industrial R&D content, technology level and innovative aspect
 - Project plan and suitability of organization's infrastructure
 - Potential economic and social benefits of project outcomes.
- 60% (for large firms) – 75% (for SME's) of project expenditures deemed eligible in the monitoring phase are granted to the beneficiary. This grant is exempt from taxation according to Law no:5746.
